La Festa di San Giuseppe (The Feast of St. Joseph)

San Giuseppe is the stepfather of Jesus. In Christianity he is an important figure. In the Catholic religion he is celebrated during Lent. If the day of his celebration falls during Holy Week, it is moved to the closest possible day before March 19, otherwise it is that day. It is usually the Saturday before Holy Week. Different Christian religions and different countries celebrate his day at different times. In Italy, particularly in Sicily, San Giuseppe is regarded as their patron saint, likewise in many Italian American communities. The rationale for him being the patron saint of Sicily is that the Sicilians credit him with preventing a famine during the middle ages

There was a severe drought and the people of Sicily prayed to St. Joseph to bring rain, promising him that if the rains did come they would have a feast to honor him. The rains came and in response the people celebrated him with a feast. The *fava* bean was what kept the people from starving; consequently, the *fava* bean is an principal part of St. Joseph's Day celebration; to eat the *fava* on that day brings good luck for the year. Some other traditional things in celebrating the day are the wearing of something red (similar to wearing of the green for St. Patrick), and making and eating *zeppole*. There is the building of a three tier altar (*La Tavola di San Giuseppe*), the three tiers represent the Trinity. On these tiers are placed, flowers, candles, wine, fava beans, cakes, breads, *Sfinge di San Giuseppe*, cookies and bread crumbs. The bread crumbs represent saw dust, since Joseph was a carpenter. Since his day occurs during Lent, the feast is meatless. In Italy March 19, is also Father's Day.

It is also traditional for many families to make *Pane di San Giuseppe*, St. Joseph's bread in celebration of his day. For those who know how to bake, the recipe is, 3 cups of unbleached flour, 1 tbsp. of yeast, 1 tbsp. honey, 2/3 cup of warm water, 1/2 tsp of salt, 2 tbsp. of butter, 3 tbsp. of anise, and 1/3 cup of golden raisins. Make the dough adding the raisins, raise in a well oiled bowl with cover for an hour, lightly knead the dough again, at this point you can make a *treccia*, (a three strand braid). Raise the dough again for 30 minutes on a greased baking sheet with a light towel on top. When time to bake, spritz it with water and place in a 350 degree oven for 35-40 minutes. *Buon Apettito*.
